graduated, Missouri Auction School, 1982; attended, The Pennsylvania State University; farmer; auctioneer; auditor, Spring Township (1978-1983); supervisor, Spring Township (1984-1995); elected, commissioner, Perry County (1996-2004); elected as a Republican to the Pennsylvania House of Representatives to the 2005 term; reelected to the House for 7 more consecutive terms; appointed, Deputy Whip (2009-2018); Retired from the house December 2020.
